**Abstract:** Description of the syntactical structures in Old English, in which the demonstrative pronouns (*se* and *ðis*) occur independently of a following nominal phrase: structural classification, characterization and analysis of their internal structure and their function in the text by a comprehensive examination of the examples in the corpus, *Ælfric’s Lives of Saints*.
