

OWL



SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MATERIALS:

- 1 medium/4 worsted yarn – brown
- 1 Medium/4 worsted yarn – cream
- 1 medium/4 worsted yarn – yellow
- 1 medium/4 worsted yarn – black
- Scraps of orange yarn, and red yarn
- 2.75mm crochet hook
- 1 pair of 12 mm safety eyes, brown
- Polyester fiberfill for stuffing
- Stitch marker
- Felt: orange, white and light brown
- Yarn needle
- Glue gun, or fabric glue
- Ribbon, dark blue

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain
st = stitch
sc = single crochet
inc = increase
dec = dec
rnd = round

This amigurumi is crocheted in continuous spirals without joining the rounds.

The finish size of this plush is approx. 5 inch tall (12.5mm)

Happy crocheting!

HEAD/BODY:

With brown yarn, start with magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in center of the ring (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: [1 sc, inc] 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: [2 sc, inc] 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: [3 sc, inc] 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: sc in each st round (30)

Rnd 7: [4 sc, inc] 6 times (36)

Rnd 8 to 11: sc in each st around (36)

Change yarn to cream yarn

Rnd 12 to 21: sc in each st around (36)

Hold you work, do not fasten off. Cut 2 pieces of light brown felt in an oval shape. Cut a hole in the center, and insert the eyes in the felt.

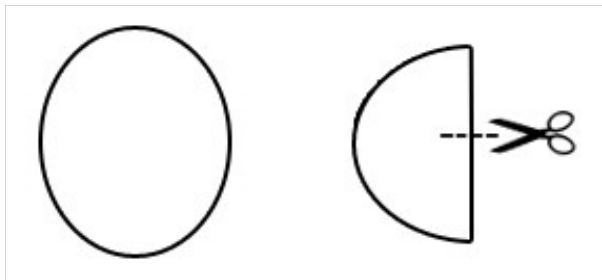
Insert the eyes into a stitch of the body at round 9 from the top. Stuff the body with fiberfill.

Rnd 22: [4 sc, dec] 6 times (30)

Rnd 23: [3 sc, dec] 6 times (24)

Rnd 24: [2 sc, dec] 6 times (18)

Fasten off, finish stuffing, and weave the loose end into the stitches.



Fold the felt in two, and cut a little opening in the center for the eyes.



The two pieces of felt should touch in the middle.

BOTTOM:

Using cream yarn, start with magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in center of the ring (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: [1 sc, inc] 6 times (18)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the bottom to the body using a thread needle, add stuffing if necessary. Just make sure the bottom remains flat or your owl won't be able to stand. Weave in loose ends.

Insert the thread into the stitches of the body, then in the stitches of the wings to sew them together.

WINGS (make 2):

Using brown yarn, start with magic ring

Rnd 1: 5 sc in center of the ring (5)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around. (10)

Rnd 3: [1 sc, inc] 5 times (15)

Rnd 4 to 7: sc in each st around (15)

Rnd 8: [1 sc, dec] 5 times (10)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
Do not stuff them, they will remain flat.

Sew the wings on each side of the body.
Weave in loose ends.

Use the stitches of both parts to sew them together.

Cut a piece of orange felt for the beak and two for the feet.



Shape of the beak, and feet.

Glue the felt around the eyes with a glue gun or fabric glue, then the beak on top of it. Glue the feet under the body.

CAP:

Bottom:

With black yarn, make a magic ring

Rnd 1: 5 sc in center of the ring (5)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (10)

Rnd 3: [1 sc, inc] 5 times (15)

Rnd 4: [2 sc, inc] 5 times (20)

Fasten off, and leave a long tail for sewing.
Set aside.

Top (make 2):

With black yarn, ch. 13

Row 1: sc in 2nd st from hook, 11 sc (12)

Row 2 to 11: ch. 1, sc in 2nd chain from hook, 11 sc (12)

Fasten off, cut the thread of the first rectangle and weave in the loose end. Do not fasten off the second one, put it on top of the other and slip stitch around the edges to embroider the two parts together. Fasten off, and weave in the loose ends.



The three parts of the cap.



Slip stitch the two rectangles together.

Sew the bottom of the cap on top of the head. Stuff it just a little bit as you go.



The cap sewed to the head.

Pour a little bit of glue on top of the bottom cap (use a glue gun, or fabric glue), and top it with the upper part of the cap.

TASSEL:

Cut 10 inch of thread in some orange yarn. Using your yarn needle, insert it in the stitches at the center of the cap. Make a double knot.



Cut 5 more strands, and fold them over the first thread, make a tight knot.





Get all the threads together, cut another piece of thread and tie it over all the threads with a double knot. Cut the extra strands of threads to make them even.



DIPLOMA:

Cut a 2 x 1.5 in. rectangle in some white felt, roll it and glue as you go.

Cut a little piece of red yarn, fold it over the felt and make a double knot.

Glue the diploma on the side of the body, a little bit underneath the wing, and sideways.



Cut a piece of ribbon, insert it through the stitches in front of the body with a yarn needle, and make a bow.
